
Installation Procedure

PLEASE NOTE: This product is supplied with a Pressure Reducing Valve, which MUST be installed between the water source and the Hand Rinse/Spray, and it MUST also be set to 1 Bar.

An under-counter weight is also supplied, for smooth operation of the Hose.

- 1. Prior to installation please ensure that all supply pipes have been flushed through to remove any debris and then ensure the water supply is turned off.
- 2. We strongly recommend the fitting of isolation valves to the inlet feeds for ease of future maintenance.
- 3. Place the Cylinder and Thread along with the Ring and Washer through the hole cut on the counter top/bath.
 - 4. Secure from underneath with the Retaining Nut.
 - 5. Attach the Hose to the Hand Rinse/spray ensuring all Washers are in place.
 - 6. Feed through the Deck-mounted Holder from above. This Hand Rinse/spray will seat in place on the Holder.
 - 7. Connect the water supply to the Hose ensuring the Washer is in place.
 - 8. Turn on the water supply and check all water feed connections to ensure that there are no leaks.
- 9. Check the assembled fit of the products to the sanitary ware/bath to ensure there is no water ingress that may cause water damage after installation.
